SPECIAL FACILITY CONSTRUCTION ACCOUNT (SFCA) FOR CMHS CONSTRUCTION PROJECT: John Lott, Assistant Superintendent, said he received a phone call from Parrish McCall, CRA and they said additional Geotechnical Studies will need to be done for the new CMHS. These additional studies will cost approximately \$500,000.00; therefore, the District School Board Resolution needs to be amended to include the \$500,000 for additional studies. The old amount is \$36,748,490 and now the revised amount is \$37,248,490 for construction of the new CMHS. After discussion, Paige Brookins moved to approve the additional amount for Geotechnical Studies and approve the revised District School Board Resolution, second by Cameron Asbell, motion carried.
