

CHAPTER 8.00 - MAINTENANCE SERVICES

8.03* - Inspections

POLICY:

- (1) All school buildings shall be inspected at least once during each school fiscal year by a person who is certified by the Florida Department of Education. Such inspection shall be conducted to determine compliance with State Board of Education Rules Chapter 6A-2 and shall include, but not be limited to, wiring, plumbing, structural parts, safety hazards, and general repair needs. A copy of such inspection report(s) shall be submitted to the principal, Superintendent, and School Board.
- (2) Fire safety inspections of all buildings shall be conducted annually by the Division of the State Fire Marshall or, upon approval, a local fire department official who has successfully completed the required training courses and is certified by the Division of the State Fire Marshall as fire safety inspector.
- (3) If a serious fire hazard is identified, action may be taken in accordance with Policy 8.15.
