Knowledge of common student illnesses. Must have knowledge of student physical and mental handicaps and basic health and first aid procedures. Knowledge of school health program guidelines and regulations. Skilled in pediatric medically complex procedures such as but not limited to, gastrostomy tube feedings, airway suctioning, blood glucose monitoring, and intermittent clean catheterization. Ability to transfer students from and safely use wheelchairs, beds, walkers, Hoyer-lifts and other special needs equipment.

Principal/Registered Nurse

JOB GOAL

To ensure the health and safety of assigned students and to provide medical assistance to students in your care.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide services, within the scope of licensure, to meet the medical needs of identified students, including but not limited to suctioning, gastrointestinal tube feeding, nebulizer treatments, and other medical needs.

- 4) Consult with the Registered Nurse as necessary or appropriate.
- 5) Manage or assist in managing emergency health needs.
