CHAPTER 2.00 - SCHOOL BOARD GOVERNANCE AND ORGANIZATION

2.18 - School Year

POLICY:

- (1) The school year for all pupils except graduating seniors shall consist of 180 days of actual instruction.
- (2) The school year for graduating twelfth grade students shall be reduced from 180 days to 176 days, the reduction to be taken off the last four (4) days of the last attendance month of the regular year. This reduction will not result in a reduction in state funding to the Board. (1000.01 (16))
- (3) The school year for ten (10) month's contract instructional personnel will be established by the Board annually. The Board, on recommendation from the Superintendent, may employ instructional personnel beyond the regular school year for additional days to be used under the direction of the principal.
- (4) The school year for twelve (12) month's contract personnel shall be a year of actual service except for holidays duly established by the Board.
