Willing to participate in District in-service programs.

JOB GOAL

To plan and implement a developmentally appropriate curriculum for prekindergarten students; and to motivate to motivate students to develop the skills and knowledge needed that will enable them to be better prepared for entrance into kindergarten.

SUPERVISES:

Child Development Associate Aide

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- * (1) Become familiar with the philosophy of the Pre-Kindergarten Program and engage in appropriate study and training to implement the philosophy; maintain professional competence.
- * (2) Provide learning experiences in subject matter suited to the needs of students.
- * (3) Develop and use instructional materials suitable for instruction of students with wide range of mental, physical, and emotional maturities.
- (4) Develop in each student an awareness of his / her worth as an individual and his / her role in the family and community.
- * (5) Encourage students to express themselves creatively in art, music and dramatic play.
- * (6) Provide individual and small group instruction designed to meet individual needs of students in communication skills, health habits, physical skills, and development of satisfactory self-concepts. Work with other support personnel / agencies to promote this goal.
- (7) Enrich educational program through study trips to community resources such as museums, parks, and through classroom visits by resource persons from the school and community. Share and interpret these experiences with students and parents.
- * (8) Plan and coordinate the work of aides, assistants, parents, and volunteers in the classroom and on field trips in order to obtain the maximum benefit from their efforts.

- * (9) Develop activities for parents which promote parent participation and involvement in education activities provided for their children; and communicate with them regularly.
- (10) Interpret school program to parents in order to strengthen parental understanding of the individual student's needs and the school's role in the individual's life.
- *(11) Provide appropriate climate to establish and reinforce acceptable student behavior, attitudes, and social skills.
- (12) Cooperate with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students solve health, attitude and learning problems.
- *(13) Create an effective environment for learning through functional and attractive displays, interest centers, and exhibits of student's work.
- (14) Select and requisition books, instructional aids, instructional supplies, and food.
- (15) Participate in curriculum and other developmental programs as appropriate.
- (16) Perform other duties consistent with the goals and objectives of this position.
- *(17) Alert the Pre-kindergarten early intervention teacher and principal to any problems or special concerns involving the Pre-kindergarten students.
- *(18) Maintain accurate and complete records as required by law, district policy and administrative regulations; and maintain confidentiality of information concerning students.
- *(19) Uphold and enforce school rules, and School Board policies.
- *(20) Ability to work in a constant state of alertness and safe manner.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Medium Work: Exerting up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently and/or up to 10 pounds of force as needed to move objects.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:
