REGULAR SESSION

The School Board of Levy County met in Regular Session this 10th day of March, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. with Board Chairman Paige Brookins, Chris Cowart, Cameron Asbell, Ashley Clemenzi, Brad Etheridge and Board Attorney David Delaney present.

Adoption of Agenda: Chris Cowart moved to approve the agenda, second by Ashley Clemenzi, motion carried.

Welcome Visitors: Board Chairman Paige Brookins welcomed all the visitors and asked if anyone from the audience would like to address the Board. Ms. Alice Monyei, Chairperson for the Ernest A. Haile Memorial Committee addressed the Board and shared information about the “Buy a Brick Program”, a fundraiser for the Ernest A. Haile Memorial Wall located at the City of Chiefland Eddie Buie Park in Chiefland, Florida. She said the event will be held at the park May 30, 2020.

BMHS CTE Presentation – Gaming/Simulation/Programming: Carol DuBois, Coordinator of Career Pathways and Literacy introduced students from BMHS who are enrolled in the CTE FBLA Program. Instructor Michael Wilson introduced students Jared Monje-Crespo, Austin Strickland, and Timothy Snyder. They shared some of their activities that they do in the gaming/simulation/programming. They showed a PowerPoint of the game they developed. They said they won the district competition and are anxious about competing at the state level.

WES ESOL Community Classrooms: Jaime Handlin and Becky Childs gave a PowerPoint presentation showing how the ESOL community classrooms operate on a daily schedule. Valerie Boughanem said this project is part of the Stellar Grant. It was a five year grant and this is the last year to be sponsored through the Stellar Program. She said we have seven teachers pursuing their doctorate, masters and a specialist degree at UF and their education is paid through the Stellar Grant. Ms. Handlin said the Williston schools serve the highest ELL student population of all the Levy County Schools. They shared data comparisons since the program began and said the ELA math and science showed gradual gains over the last four years. They showed a video of some ELL students and what all is included in their daily schedule.

Superintendent's Comments/Recommendations: Superintendent Jeff Edison said the student field trips to Italy have been postponed until summer 2020. He shared the list of past SRF purchases by the Board and said their purchase this year needs to be from one of the Williston schools. The ad for the rodeo booklet was discussed. He said there are several events coming up within the next few weeks and they will be monitored and cancelled or changed as needed, due to the Coronavirus outbreak. He referred everyone to the Levy Disaster.com website for updates on the COVID-19. He said the Department of Health has the final say regarding the virus. Mr. Edison said we had a Financial Audit exit interview today and received entrance papers for another audit beginning for the CTE Monitoring visit.

Board Comments: Chris Cowart said funding for K-12 is still being determined. He gave a legislative update on the FTE funding projected for the new fiscal year, teachers proposed salaries, and public education. She said YTS will be participating in the small animal category at the SRF. Mrs. Clemenzi thanked everyone for their prayers, cards and support after her son's accident. Brad Etheridge said he enjoyed the ELL video. He said this is a very busy time of the year with the fair, testing, proms, field trips and soon will be graduation. He said Levy County has strong support for our students and student scholarships. He said the WMHS FFA placed 3rd last week at the meat judging competition. Mr. Etheridge said he and Chris Cowart were judges for the FFA Horticulture completion and it was very enjoyable. Paige Brookins said the SRF is a long standing fair for the tri-county area and is very important for Levy County. She thanked Chris Cowart for keeping everyone updated and informed with the legislation. She said we had great presentations tonight.
