JOB GOAL

To maintain the physical facilities in the District in good condition and to provide installation and maintenance of plumbing needs so that the facilities will function in a safe and healthful manner.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- * (1) Repair water lines and leaking faucets.
- * (2) Unclog sewer lines and commodes.
- * (3) Read blueprints and install new lines according to plans.
- * (4) Provide plumbing services to all sites as requested by work orders.
- (5) Inspect plumbing and report needs to the Director, Maintenance for budget purposes.
- (6) Call in contractor to perform tasks which maintenance crews cannot perform.
- (7) Inventory supplies, materials and equipment.
- (8) Provide information needed to prepare budget for fiscal year.
- (9) Assist the air conditioning maintenance man in equipment repair and installation of cold water lines.
- (10) Assist other tradesmen as needed.
- (11) Perform other incidental tasks consistent with the goals and objectives of this position.
- *(12) Ability to work in a constant state of alertness and safe manner.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Heavy Work: Exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently and/or up to 20 pounds of force as needed to move objects.
