CHAPTER 10.00 - FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICES

10.10 - Admission to Work Areas; Use and Protection of Equipment and Supplies

POLICY:

- (1) A child is to be allowed into the kitchen only if:
 - (a) He/she is employed in accordance with the Child Labor Laws or
 - (b) He/she is on tour with a group as part of a nutrition project prearranged with the principal and manager.
- (2) Campus staff and visitors will be served from the serving lines. Special items for adults, such as coffee and tea, will be served, when available, from a table at a designated place in the dining room.
- (3) Only School Food and Nutrition Service personnel and adults on official school food service business are allowed behind serving counters.
- (4) School food service refrigeration shall be used only for storage and preservation of food to be used on the school premises or in connection with Board approved activities.
- (5) Foods or equipment shall not be removed from the school premises except in connection with Board approved activities. Any employee who violates this rule shall be subject to suspension and subsequent dismissal from employment.
- (6) Relatives of School Food and Nutrition Service employees shall be granted no privileges denied other children and adults.
