CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

3.18 - Releasing Children from School

POLICY:

The principal or teacher shall definitely establish the identity and authority of any person who requests the release of a child from school. If the person requesting the release of the child is a person other than the parent or guardian having custody of the child, the principal or teacher concerned shall not release the child without the consent of the parent or guardian having custody of the child.

A pupil shall be released to a law enforcement officer provided the principal is properly notified as to the purpose. Where such release is made, the parent or guardian of the pupil should be notified.
