REGULAR SESSION

The School Board of Levy County met in Regular Session this 11th day of February, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. with Board Chairman Paige Brookins, Chris Cowart, Cameron Asbell, Ashley Clemenzi and Board Attorney David Delaney present. Brad Etheridge was absent.

Adoption of Agenda: Chris Cowart moved to approve the agenda, second by Cameron Asbell, motion carried.

<u>Welcome Visitors</u>: Board Chairman Paige Brookins welcomed all the visitors and asked if anyone from the audience would like to address the Board. There were none.

CTE Presentation: Carol DuBois, Coordinator of Career Pathways and Literacy introduced students from CMHS and WMHS who are enrolled in the CTE Programs. They shared some of their activities that they do in the different programs. She introduced the CTE teachers, CMHS: Christina Smith; WMHS: Natalie Couey, Austin Skipper and Travis Bergdoll. CMHS students Angela Porras, Margarita Ramos and Alicia Jones demonstrated how they use the Digital Design Program to create key chains for each Board members. They talked about the Industry Certifications, Projects and FBLA. The WMS FFA students Savanna Jerrels and Grace Dola shared details of their upcoming FFA week celebration, February 24-28, 2020. WHS FFA Chase Eschbach and Adam Sistrunk demonstrated how they participate in FFA competitions for meat judging. She said Pam Plemmons is the teacher for Cooperative Diversified Education (CDE) Program. This program allows students to be placed in job related to their CTE certificates. She said for the 2019-2020 SY, 1,042 students are enrolled in CTE classes throughout Levy County. The Board commented on how valuable the CDE program is for students to be able to receive the experience in real-life jobs. They said CDE is an excellent opportunity for students to learn how to interact with people, learn about earning money, dependability and responsibility.

2020-2021 Levy County School Calendar: Marla Hiers, Director of Personnel shared the new 2020-2021 SY Levy County School Calendars A and B with the Board. She said votes for the calendars were 343 for "A" and 88 for "B". After discussion, Cameron Asbell moved to approved Calendar A, second by Ashley Clemenzi, motion carried.
