CHAPTER 4.00 - CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

4.04 - Promotions and Retentions

POLICY:

- (1) Any pupil in elementary school who has earned a final passing grade average during the entire school year and meets state and district proficiency levels for promotion shall be promoted.
- (2) Interim reports are required for all students at the end of four and one-half (4 1/2) weeks of each grading period or more if appropriate in grades K-12.
- (3) No child shall be retained in any grade without a conference with the parent or guardian of the child, or without the parent or guardian having been given an opportunity for such conference at least six (6) weeks prior to the close of school.
- (4) Any double promotion and any retention shall be made only with the written consent of the principal and the teacher or teachers involved. Such consent shall be made a part of the pupil's permanent record. Consultation with the parent or guardian of the child should be held prior to making any decision regarding such promotion or retention.
- (5) Complete information on promotions and retentions are contained in the Student Progression Plan.
