## CHAPTER 6.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

## 6.14 - Outside Employment

## <u>POLICY</u>

Outside employment or "moonlighting" on the part of an employee shall not violate the moral standards of the community or the Code of Ethics of the Education Profession in Florida. Under no conditions shall outside employment conflict with the employee's performance of his/her professional duties or with the extracurricular activities related to his/her position.

- (1) No member of the instructional or administrative staff shall be permitted to sell instructional materials to the parents or guardian of a child who is a member of his/her class or under his/her supervision.
- Where the principal questions the propriety of any outside employment of a faculty member under his/her supervision, he/she may require the employee to confer with the Superintendent and to follow his/her directions. A member of the administrative staff shall be directly responsible to the Superintendent. Where the employee refuses to follow the instructions of the Superintendent or feels that his/her rights have been violated, the matter shall be referred to the Board.
