CHAPTER 4.00 - CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

4.26 - Sale of Textbooks by School Board

POLICY:

- (1) New textbooks, which are unused and in current adoption, may be purchased by the public from the principal's office at the net wholesale price paid by the state f.o.b., the Florida Depository, or the publisher.
- (2) The principal, when requested by the parent of a pupil in the school where he/she is employed, shall sell to such parent, at cost, any instructional materials used by the school. (1006.28 (3), F.S.)
- (3) If used textbooks are available, they may be purchased from the principal's office at the following rates:
 - (a) New book (issued first time) total purchase price;
 - (b) A book in use less that two (2) years 75% of purchase price;
 - (c) A book in use for more than two (2) years and suitable for distribution and in current adoption 50% of purchase price; or
 - (d) Where a book has been damaged or is beyond normal usage and the above rules do not apply, the principal shall assess the amount of the purchase price on the basis of the book's condition.
- (4) The following legend shall be stamped in each book which is sold:

"SOLD BY THE SCHOOL BOARD OF LEVY COUNTY."
