CHAPTER 10.00 – FOOD AND NUTRITION SERVICES

10.01* - General Food Service Requirements

POLICY:

- (1) The School Food and Nutrition Services program shall operate according to requirements set forth in Florida Statutes and State Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services rules. The School Food and Nutrition Services program shall include the federally reimbursed lunch program, a la carte food, beverage offerings, and sale of food and beverage items offered through vending machines or other methods to students at all school facilities during the school day and may include other federally reimbursed Child Nutrition Programs.
- (2) The school food service program shall be an integral part of the District's educational program, offering nutritional and educational opportunities to students.
- (3) Foods and beverages available in schools shall be only those which meet the nutritional needs of students and contribute to the development of desirable health habits unless provided otherwise by State Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services rules and approved by the Superintendent.
- (4) The school food service program shall meet the standards for Food Service and Sanitation and Safety as provided by the Florida State Board of Health and Florida State Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
