CHAPTER 11.00 SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS AND INTERLOCAL AGREEMENTS

11.06 - Visitors

POLICY:

Any person entering the premises of a school shall report to the principal or his/her supervisory designee and make known the purpose of the visit.

- (1) This policy does apply to routine deliveries or scheduled maintenance visits.
- (2) A student not enrolled in the school or a student not accompanied by a parent or guardian is prohibited from visiting a school unless otherwise approved by the principal.
- (3) Parents/guardians are invited to visit the schools. To avoid interrupting the daily program, the parent should request a conference for after school hours or during a teacher's conference period. Parents/guardians are encouraged to plan such conferences with teachers and shall sign in at the principal's office and be issued a visitor's badge at the time they arrive on the campus.
- (4) Any person who enters or remains upon District property without a legitimate purpose may be found to be trespassing and, therefore, in violation of Florida Statutes and subject to arrest and penalties as defined by statutes.
