

CHAPTER 6.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

6.42 - Physical Examinations

POLICY

- (1) The employee, at the expense of the Board, shall, upon request of the Board at any time during the school term, submit to a physical, psychological and/or psychiatric examination by a qualified physician or physicians to be selected by the employee from a list containing of not less than three (3) names approved by the Board when, in the School Board=s judgment, such an examination is relevant to the teaching performance or employment status of a School Board employee. The employee shall allow the report of the physician or physicians to be submitted to the Board, with a copy being forwarded to the employee.
- (2) Where necessary, to determine whether to continue the services of an employee, the Board reserves the right to require a physical or psychiatric examination by a qualified physician or psychiatrist to be chosen by the employee from a list of doctors approved by the Board. In the event such medical examination is required, the Board will pay all costs.
