EXECUTIVE SESSION

The School Board of Levy County met in Executive Session this 19th day of February, 2013 at 8:15 a.m. with Chairman Cameron Asbell, Robert Philpot, Rick Turner, Chris Cowart, Paige Brookins and Board Attorney David Delaney present.

Expulsion Hearings: The Board heard information regarding recommendations for expulsion.

- 1) **Student 13-11** (student and parent *absent*): Superintendent Hastings informed the Board that the parent and student would not be able to attend the hearing because they were in Jacksonville due to a family medical emergency. Superintendent Hastings made the recommendation that the Expulsion Hearing be continued until the March 5, 2013 Board Meeting. Paige Brookins moved, with second by Chris Cowart, to approve the recommendation of the Superintendent, motion carried.
- 2) **Student 13-12** (student, parent and grandparent present): Paige Brookins moved, with second by Chris Cowart, to approve the recommendation of the Superintendent that in the best interest of the student the expulsion be cancelled and the student be administratively placed at Hilltop Alternative School for the remainder of the 2012-2013 school year where they will receive anger management counseling. The student's progress will be monitored by the principal at Hilltop, who will make a recommendation to the Superintendent as to when the student is ready to re-enter the regular school setting. REGULAR SESSION

Very Special Arts Florida: Dr. Rosalind Hall directed the Board Members' attention to the artwork displayed in the back of the room. She told them that she was able, thru a grant from Very Special Arts Florida, to bring in an artist to work with ESE students at CES and the artwork displayed was theirs. She then introduced the CES Teacher, Christie Jones, who explained to the Board how the program had positively impacted her students. Next, Ms. Jones introduced the Artist from Ocala - Marlene Jacobowitz, who explained how she worked with the students to create the artwork. Next, Pat York from Very Special Arts Florida explained to the Board that the mission of VSAFL is to create a society in which people with disabilities can learn through, participate in and enjoy the arts. Dr. Hall thanked the Board for their support and gave each of the Board Members and the Superintendent a "paint-by-numbers" kit so they could participate in the arts themselves.

Superintendent's Comments / Recommendations: Superintendent Hastings informed the Board that Congressman Ted Yoho would host a "Town Hall" Meeting at the Hilltop Auditorium on Thursday afternoon, beginning at 5:30 p.m. He also shared that WES had collected \$440.00 to send to the Sandy Hook Elementary School showing their support after the tragedy there. He commended the school for their generosity and said that's the kind of people we have in our communities and schools in Levy County. He reminded the Board they were having lunch with the National FFA Advisor Dr. Steve Brown at BMHS after the meeting today. He then asked Dr. Wnek to report on negotiation results. Dr. Wnek said we are in tentative agreement with LCEA at this point. He said both sides are concerned with the budget situation and the fund balance being below 3%. He said the LCEA will vote on March 5th and the Board would have the results at that time. Next, Mr. Hastings called for Jeff Edison to report on the trip he and several others took to look at a Flagler County School site that would be similar to the new Williston Middle High School. Mr. Edison said the group was impressed with the building. He said Paul Stresing, the board architect, said the building plans could be modified to better fit the needs of the New WMHS. He said the campus layout was very secure and the group really liked that feature.

Board Comments: Chris Cowart gave information about the Cedar Key Arts Festival. Paige Brookins requested that at a future Board Meeting there be a discussion regarding Valedictorian and Salutatorian information. She said there is always a conflict with the way it's done and she would like to review alternate ways other counties are using to determine Val and Sal. Superintendent Hastings said Mr. Edison can do a zoomerang poll of other counties through FADSS and bring the info to a future board meeting for discussion. Mrs. Brookins also asked if something could be done to more clearly define discipline responses for students who have been expelled but were cleared by the Board to return to their home schools from Hilltop before their expulsion time was up. She said perhaps those students should have a more strict discipline response than students who have never been expelled. Mr. Edison said that would probably involve changing the Code of Student Conduct and would research that. Mrs. Brookins also reported that the Science Fair Recognition

night in Ocala that she attended was great – she was very proud of Levy County students. Cameron Asbell reminded the Board of the Williston FFA IFAS function.

There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting was adjourned with the Board agreeing to cancel the Executive Session.
