PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- * (1) Confer regularly with principals, teachers, other student service disciplines and school specialists regarding children with learning and behavior problems.
- * (2) Make home visits as a follow-up to exceptional student education referrals and reevaluations.
- * (3) Observe and interview children in school and / or home settings, individually and in groups, for evaluative and remedial purposes.
- * (4) Act as liaison between home and school to obtain, share, clarify and coordinate information.
- * (5) Enlist the cooperation of the parents in examining the family situation and together assess the strengths and the problem areas.
- (6) Assist parents to see how they can contribute positively to their child's growth and development.
- (7) Assist families to improve their relationship with the school.
- (8) Help families understand and accept services from other community agencies when such specialized assistance is necessary.
- (9) Work cooperatively with appropriate community health, education and welfare resources, sharing, obtaining and coordinating information, reports, recommendations and activities for maximum use of all resources.
- (10) Assist with the transportation of students and / or parents to appropriate community health, education and welfare resources when necessary in planning for the student.

- (11) Participate in interpretation, implementation and working through of staffing recommendations.
- (12) Consult with faculty individually or in groups to aid in developing educational and social work plans which will enhance learning, personal growth and development of all children.
- (13) Initiate and / or participate in in-service training, studies and research relevant to social work provided to schools.
- (14) Participate in activities of professional, civic and community organizations in order to develop and improve family life and community resources.
- (15) Help to improve students' attendance at schools, which may include coordinating services with HRS, school office staff, parents and students.
- (16) Provide individual and group counseling with children and parents when necessary.
- Write and maintain social services reports and records pertaining to referrals for special school service programs.
- (18) Perform other incidental tasks consistent with the goals and objectives of this position.
- *(19) Ability to work in a constant state of alertness and safe manner.
