# Bronson, Florida June 22, 2010 8:45 a.m. Executive Session

The School Board of Levy County met in session this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 2010 with Chairman Beth Davis, Rick Turner, Paige Brookins, Cameron Asbell, Frank Etheridge and Board Attorney Sheree Lancaster present.

**Expulsion Hearing**: The Board heard information regarding recommendation for expulsion. After testimony was given by the Principal and/or Designee, the following action was taken by the Board.

1) **Student 10-27** (student and parent *absent*): Motion by Frank Etheridge, second by Rick Turner, to approve the recommendation of the Superintendent that the student be expelled for the 2010-2011 school year and the 2011-2012 school year, without educational services, motion carried.

The Board then returned to regular session to continue with the remaining business of the Board.

<u>District Report:</u> Dr. Tovine presented information to the Board regarding the "Safe Routes to School" Grant, a federal grant funded by the FL DOT to encourage children, including those with disabilities, to walk or bicycle to school. She shared a power point that presented the proposals for additional sidewalks, crosswalks and speed bumps at the Williston and Chiefland schools. She said the Grant was submitted in April and the School Board would receive notification in November if awarded the grant money.

<u>Superintendent Recommendation:</u> The Superintendent informed the Board that in light of receiving a resignation letter from Dana Davis, he has withdrawn the petition to suspend without pay. (see Consent Agenda, a) **Employee Status Changes**, item 18).

Amendment of Agenda: Board Chair Beth Davis then asked that the Agenda be amended for good cause, allowing Bob Clemons to present the TRIM Plan A Calendar and for Board Attorney Sheree Lancaster to address the Board regarding the Kathryn F. d) Request permission to post a budget amendment as of June 30, 2010 and pay vouchers on July 6 with the details to be presented to the Board at the July 6, 2010 Board Meeting.

<u>Causey Estate Document</u>: Board Attorney Sheree Lancaster shared with the Board the "Receipt of Beneficiary, Waiver of Accounting and Service of Petition for Discharge, and Consent to Distribution and Discharge" concerning the Kathryn F. Causey Estate, requesting approval by the Board. A motion was made by Paige Brookins, seconded by Cameron Asbell to approve the document, motion carried.

<u>Superintendent's Comments / Recommendations</u>: Mr. Hastings informed the Board that even without the Union's signature on the application, the School Board will be considered for receiving Race To The Top funds if awarded. He said it would mean 1.1 million dollars over a 4 year period to the district. He also said he anticipates the state legislature going into special session once the economic impact of the oil spill in the gulf has been assessed. The Superintendent requested that the Board go into Executive Session to reconsider an expulsion recommendation following the close of the meeting. There being no further business to come before the board, the meeting was adjourned.

**Executive Session:** The superintendent then requested that the Board reconsider his previous recommendation for expulsion on **student 10-27**, stating he would like to amend the recommendation. A motion was made by Cameron Asbell, seconded by Rick Turner to reconsider the Superintendent's recommendation for expulsion of **student 10-27**, motion carried. Board attorney Sheree Lancaster then reminded the Board that a student could only be expelled for the remainder of the current year and one more year. Since the request for expulsion was received from the school during the 2009/10 school year, even

though it was received June 28, 2010, 1 week prior to school closing, expulsion could only be for the remainder of the current year and the next school year. After hearing the reminder, Cameron Asbell made a motion to fail the Superintendent's recommendation to expel **student 10-27** for the 2010-2011 school year and the 2011-2012 school year, seconded by Frank Etheridge, motion carried. The Superintendent then made a new recommendation to expel **student 10-27** for the 2010-2011 school year without educational services. A motion was made by Rick Turner, seconded by Cameron Asbell to approve the recommendation of the Superintendent, motion carried.
