CHAPTER 6.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

6.32 - Pupil Supervision

POLICY

Proper supervision of a pupil shall be provided while he/she is under the immediate control of the school. Supervision of pupils shall be maintained on the school grounds, in classrooms, in pupil occupied areas of buildings, on field trips, during any extracurricular activity, at school-sponsored functions, and at any other school related or sponsored activity. (1003.31) Any member of the instructional staff or teacher aide who has responsibility for the supervision of pupils in the performance of his/her normal duties or who is assigned duty requiring the supervision of pupils and who fails to provide such pupil supervision by failing to report for duty or by leaving his/her post of duty without being properly relieved of such duty shall be deemed guilty of neglect of duty. Any person charged with such neglect of duty shall be subject to suspension from duty and termination as provided by law.
