

CHAPTER 4.00 - CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

4.28* - Educational Enhancement

POLICY:

- (1) Educational Enhancement is defined as:
 - (a) Special services offered by the district which are not required by the state, and
 - (b) An offering of selected courses/programs that are not identified as core subject areas; i.e., math, science, social studies, English, and courses that are not specifically required for graduation.
- (2) Expenditures related to the following are considered consistent with the definition of Educational Enhancement:
 - (a) Instructional Technology
 - (b) Art
 - (c) Music
 - (d) Marine Science Program
 - (e) Developmental Kindergarten
 - (f) Health Services
 1. Health Aides
 2. Contracted Health Services
 - (g) Alternative Educational Programs
 - (h) Programs/Services put in abeyance by the 1991 legislature but still maintained by the district
 - (i) School Improvement Plan
