CHAPTER 4.00 - CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

4.21 - Homework

POLICY:

Excessive homework shall not be assigned. Supervised study should be practiced in the classes. Homework is a matter of professional judgment on the part of the teacher and each teacher is expected to proceed on that basis. In a departmentalized situation, an instructor of a given course should not monopolize the student's homework time to the detriment of other courses being taught. Consideration is to be given to each student's total homework assignments and his/her overall course schedule; therefore, total homework assignments shall be kept within reasonable limits.
