CHAPTER 3.00 - SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION

3.19 - School Discipline

POLICY:

- (1) The principal is expected to see that proper discipline is maintained throughout the school and to cooperate with teachers in attaining this objective. Unprofessional conduct in any matter relating to discipline on the part of the principal or a teacher shall be brought to the immediate attention of the Board by the Superintendent.
- (2) Each teacher is expected to promote proper pupil conduct not only within his/her own teaching situation but also throughout the school buildings and on the campus. The teacher is expected to maintain, at all times, a professional attitude in the matter of discipline and to cooperate with the principal in the overall discipline of the entire school.
- (3) The principal of the school is hereby given authority to close the school campus at any time he/she feels the situation warrants such action and the Superintendent cannot be contacted to approve such action. However, any closing of a school shall be reported immediately together with the reasons to the Superintendent. Where a school is closed, the Superintendent shall determine when and under what conditions the school will be reopened.
- (4) No student shall be punished or otherwise penalized for failure to bring money for a school project.
- (5) The principal shall review policies relating to student behavior and discipline with the faculty and student body at the beginning of each school term and at such other times as may be necessary to properly inform the student body and the faculty.
