

# OCCUPATIONAL COMPLETION POINTS (OCP)

The Florida Department of Education (DOE) has undertaken the job of restructuring vocational education curricula to be more responsive to the needs of business and industry in Florida and to improve vocational education courses for secondary students preparing to enter the work force. This restructuring is based upon occupational clusters that share a common core of basic knowledge and competencies. Many occupational programs offer the option of occupational completion points. An occupational completion point is a group of competencies or skills for a specific occupation as identified by the Dictionary of Occupational Titles (DOT), an Occupational Employment Statistics (OES) code, or an industry-defined title. For students with disabilities in a job preparatory program one or more established occupational completion points may be pursued.

The following pages outlines the OCPs for each program offered in Levy County Public Schools. There are many places that you can access the OCPs. One is the actual Framework for each program.
