The School Board of Levy County is focused on providing schools with options to successfully raise funds for various student activities.

- ♣ A non-food item or a food item that meets the Smart Snacks requirements can be <u>sold</u> anytime.
- The <u>sale</u> of foods such as doughnuts, cookie dough, etc... <u>sold</u> outside of the school day* do not need to meet Smart Snack guidelines.
- The <u>sale</u> of ready-to-eat combination foods (entrees) during the school day* is considered competitive with the Food & Nutrition Services department sales and is not permitted.
- Schools are permitted a limited amount of exemptions to <u>sell</u> items that do not meet the Smart Snack guidelines. These events:
 - Must be documented and submitted to the District Wellness Coordinator.
 - May not allow items to be sold to students during school meal service.

*defined as midnight before the school day to 30 minutes after the end of school day *
