## **LEVY COUNTY SCHOOL HEALTH TEAMS**

**The School Health Team provides** routine health screenings, first aid, pediculosis (head lice) assessments and health education that are age appropriate. The nurse also reviews medical and immunization records for completeness. School attendance is very important and it is the goal of the School Health Team to encourage and promote a healthy school environment. (*Parents/guardians requesting exemption from SH services must do so in writing within first two weeks of each school year*)

<u>Sometimes kids do get sick</u> and need a short time to recover. To protect the health of all students, school policy requires that students not attend school if they have had the following symptoms within the last 24 hours:

- Fever over 100.5 degrees Fahrenheit
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting (more than one time)
- Rash, unless they have a note from a doctor
- Uncontrolled cough and cold symptoms

**If you have health concerns** for your child please discuss this with your school nurse so a plan can be made to address your child's needs in a safe and confidential way (see listing below)

<u>When a student feels ill or is injured</u> at school, they will be issued a pass, to go directly to the health room for care and evaluation. Parents will be called for any serious illness or injury as well as any other concern the health staff may have.

**Students** may <u>NOT</u> carry medication with them to school. <u>Please review the County Medication Policy</u> for prescription and non-prescription medications (policy located at each school or SBLC website under student policies Chapter 5.15 at <a href="http://www.levyk12.org/index.cfm?p=chapter-5-policies">http://www.levyk12.org/index.cfm?p=chapter-5-policies</a>. Should you have questions or concerns, please contact your school Health Team.

Please remember that our first concern is the safety and well-being of your child. It is <u>very important</u> that we have <u>Current Emergency Contact Information</u> at all times. <u>Only</u> those persons listed by you will be contacted in the event of an emergency.
