# NOTICE OF TAX FOR SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY

The Levy County School Board will soon consider a measure to continue to impose a 1.500 mill property tax for the capital outlay projects listed herein.

This tax is in addition to the school board's proposed tax of 4.612 mills for operating expenses and is proposed solely at the discretion of the school board.

The capital outlay tax will generate approximately \$3,113,058 to be used for the following projects:
