


SECONDARY GRADES 6-12 OPTION 3 VIRTUAL Levy Student Expectations in Canvas

Levy County students enrolled in Levy Virtual School (option 3) will be assigned to highly qualified teachers that will facilitate assigning courses provided through Edgenuity. Students may need **DAILY** support with this learning model from an adult. Also, please remember that ALL students in grades K-12 should have full-time adult supervision during instructional hours.

How do I **ACCESS** my child's instruction?

Your child's instruction, assignments, activities, etc. will be delivered through a platform called Edgenuity. They will access their courses and additional resources by logging in at sislogin.edgenuity.com. Upon enrollment, students receive an email with their username and password and instructions for how to login. They should check their school email for this information.

NOTE: Some students may have previously accessed courses at their school using a login provided by their school. This is a different login than that provided for Levy Virtual and will not allow them access to these courses.



How do we learn how to use **Edgenuity**?

On the login page, there is an Orientation Video that will give a tour of the Edgenuity Student Information System (SIS) where they will be logging in each day.

How will **ATTENDANCE** be determined?

Daily attendance will be recorded based on the daily login record in your child's Edgenuity account and marked present or absent in Skyward for each day. Therefore, students should log in to their account every school day.

How do I COMMUNICATE with my child's teacher and request support?

The teacher workday is assigned by each school. Parents and students should email teachers for assistance. Teachers will return emails with questions or concerns within 24 hours. Students should check email regularly as this is how teachers will communicate with them.

HOW MUCH WORK will my child need to complete each week?

Students must keep up with daily coursework and stay on pace within the course schedule. Students are reminded each time they login if they are Ahead of Pace, On-Pace or Behind in their courses. There may be assessments, discussions, lessons, etc. that may be required occasionally during the teacher school workday and parents will need to work with the teacher to schedule these.

How will **GRADES** be assigned?

Grades for each assignment, quiz, test or exam will be recorded in the Edgenuity system. Students are able to review any completed assignments or assessments and view their grades. Final grades for each course will be reported by the teacher upon completion of the course and recorded in Skyward. Grades will NOT appear in Skyward throughout the semester.

TIP: Ask your child's teacher about getting access to a regular progress report that will keep you updated on their progress.

What **MATERIALS** are needed for the courses?

Students will need regular school supply materials (pens/pencils, notebook, etc) and a computer. Other materials may be necessary for specific lessons or activities and teachers will provide notice to families in advance to allow them time to get needed materials.

Schools will schedule an IEP, 504, or ELL meeting to update services and accommodations. Services will be provided virtually.

IMPORTANT:

**If your child does not complete the instructional expectations, teacher contact, and assessments showing successful progress in the chosen option of instruction, a conference developing an improvement plan will be scheduled. If there is no immediate response to intervention, the school problem solving team may recommend a change in instructional model based on the demonstrated academic progress of the child. Our goal is for students to be successful!
