



HB 149: Seclusion and Restraint of Students with Disabilities in Public Schools

School districts/schools are required to adopt positive behavior interventions, post on website, and identify personnel authorized.

The School Board of Levy County does not exercise seclusion. Restraints are always our last resort and only if the student is in imminent danger to oneself or others.

Personnel authorized to restrain a student are school's crisis response team (Administrators, School Counselors, Deans, Teachers and Paraprofessionals) that have received training in CPI and Verbal De-escalation provided by Florida Diagnostic Learning Resources System (FDLRS).

The *Nonviolent Crisis Intervention*[®] training program includes physical interventions and personal safety techniques, which are designed to maximize the safety of everyone involved in a crisis and learn a system of verbal intervention techniques that can help the participant recognize and address escalating behavior at its earliest stages, before it can escalate further.
